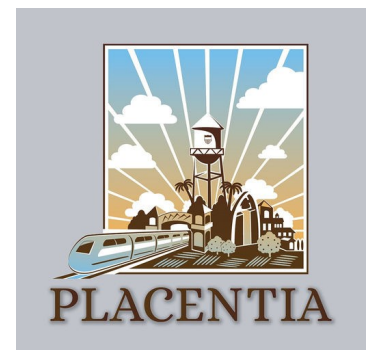

Third Grade Tours Happening

Our yearly round of Bradford House tours by local third grade students has begun. In the past we have led tours for over 600 third graders each year. Several schools have already scheduled their visit for this year including Glenknoll, Van Buren, and Ruby Drive as well as a home school group. We look forward to hearing from additional PYLUSD schools over the next few months since teachers prefer to schedule their tour between mid-February and mid-June. We are proud to continue our tradition of covering the cost of their transportation to and from the Bradford House.

On the tour students learn about local history, especially about the role of the citrus industry in the development of Orange County. They also obtain a glimpse into the lives of the pioneering families who first settled in the area such as Albert Sumner Bradford and his family, and learn about the settling of Placentia including the arrival of water and the railroad.
